Sheikh Professor Dr. Mohammad Abdul Razzag Al-Tabtabaei is the former President of Supreme Advisory Committee, the Supreme Consultative Committee on the Implementation of the Provisions of the Islamic Law, Amiri Diwan of Kuwait and the former Dean, Faculty of Shariah and Islamic Studies, Kuwait University. He is also a former member of the Shariah Advisory Council of Securities Commission Malaysia from 2012 to 2014. Currently, he serves as a member of the Shariah Committee for several Islamic financial institutions. He was appointed as a Shariah Committee member of Etiga Family & General Takaful and Independent Director, Etiga Family Takaful Berhad on 15 June 2020.
